

Tempe Town Lake and Tempe Beach Park

Mill Avenue & Rio Salado Pkwy., Tempe, AZ

▶ Sports that can be accommodated in this facility:

- Triathlon Events, Special Events, Running, Swimming, Biking, Rowing, Sailing, Kayaking, Beach Volleyball, Fishing, Boating

▶ Description:

- Tempe Town Lake, located adjacent to Downtown Tempe, provides a 2-mile recreational haven for kayaking, sailing, rowing, jogging, skating or picnicking. The park provides five miles of pathways and ample room for festivals or events, such as Ironman Arizona, various triathlons and 5K runs.

▶ Water related details:

- Lake length – 2 miles
- Lake width – about 1000 feet
- Four lane moveable race course
- Marina with five boat launches
- Boat storage space for day parking
- Fishing allowed with Arizona license – Lake stocked with trout during cool months, 12 other varieties year-round

▶ Park details:

- Surrounded by paved and gravel paths, providing more than 5 miles for running, walking or biking
- Routes for triathlons and competition 5K and 10K runs/ walks
- Outdoor venues for charity dinners, live music concerts and trade shows
- 25 acres of park space a historic ballfield, an amphitheater for concerts and trade shows, grills and picnic tables
- Restrooms
- Parking
- Concessions: negotiable based on event
- Lighting: Paths surrounding Tempe Town Lake are lit
